- 1. <u>Embryo-</u> An organism in the earliest stage of development
- 2. <u>Fertilization-</u> The process by which the female reproductive cell (egg) is united with the male reproductive cell (sperm).
- 3. <u>Germination-</u> The process by which plants begin to grow from a seed or a spore.
- 4. <u>Life cycle-</u> The stages of an organism's growth and development.
- 5. <u>Metamorphosis-</u> the process of changing from an immature form to a very different adult form
- 6. <u>Complete metamorphosis</u>- Insect development which includes the egg, larva, pupa and adult stages
- 7. <u>Incomplete metamorphosis</u>- Type of insect development which includes the stages egg, nymph, adult.
- 8. <u>Egg-</u>female reproductive cell
- 9. <u>Larva-</u> An early stage in the life cycle of an organism that will undergo complete metamorphosis.
- 10. <u>Pupa-</u> A stage in the life cycle of an insect that occurs between larva and adult.
- 11. Nymph- A pre-adult insect undergoing incomplete metamorphosis.
- 12. <u>Seed-</u>The plant structure that contains a young plant inside a protective covering
- 13. <u>Spore-</u> A seed like structure that produces a new plant. For example ferns and mosses reproduce from spores.
